To the aft, the saloon merges with the generous cockpit extended with a large aft platform. All the areas combined form a universal, open environment where flexibility and freedom reign. While housing the main helm, the flybridge is definitely dedicated to leisure with more than enough space for movable furniture, fully-equipped wet bar, a barbecue and large sun pads. The hulls provide impressive volumes to set up a custom layout including airy, luxurious guest cabins and an opulent master suite with a walk-in dressing, desk, sofa, and an immense bathroom. Origins of the name ADRIATIC are linked to Etruscan settlement of Adria, which derives its name from Illyrian "ADUR" meaning "WATER". The temperature is warm enough to stay in for hours, and cool enough to get refreshed from the midday sun. The surface water temperature ranges from 25 C (80 F) in summer to 12 C (54 F) in winter. The Adriatic sea presents crystal clear 50 shades for blue, from green turquoise to deep blue waters. Imagine waking up on Your private yacht, having breakfast on the deck, and jumping in the turquoise waters. Imagine changing backdrops of the amazing nature changing while You slide across the Sea. Everything on the Adriatic sea is cosy and intimate like your holiday escape should be.
